a. to authorise him : -

i. to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter lengths of Newport Road, Treherbert Road, Chapel Lane, Edlogan Way, New Road and The Highway;

- ii. to stop up Newport Road and Treherbert Road at or in the vicinity of their existing junctions with the Trunk Road;
- iii. to construct new highways to connect Edlogan Way and Treherbert Road to the Trunk Road, as improved;
- iv. to provide new means of access to connect Race Farm to Treherbert Road as improved, and to O.S. Field No. 3172; and
- v. to carry out temporary diversion of New Road, The Highway and the Trunk Road to enable those highways to be realigned over or alongside the new Trunk Road;
- all at New Inn, Pontypool aforesaid.
  - b. to provide for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Gwent as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.
- 2. An Order under Sections 9 and 286 of the Highways

Act 1959, Section 27 of the Local Government Act 1966 and Sections 3 and 62 of the Highways Act 1971, to authorise him to vary the powers conferred upon him by the Newport—Shrewsbury Trunk Road (New Inn By-Pass, Pontypool Side Roads) Order 1977 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1977 Order") and enables him:

- a. to decrease the size and alter the location of Avondale Road Roundabout and connecting roads pro-vided for in the 1977 Order;
- b. to amend the improvements to certain lengths of Avondale Road and Bevans Lane and to delete the improvement of the road leading to "Wrens Nest" provided for in the 1977 Order;
- c. to amend and increase the lengths of Avondale Road and Bevans Lane to be stopped up and to provide a turning area in Bevans Lane immediately northwest of the stopping up (as proposed to be varied);
- d, to delete the proposed New Road provided for in the 1977 Order connecting the proposed roundabout with Cwmbran Drive;
- e. to delete the proposed private means of access to Pontrhydyrun Farm and Brook Cottage and alter the location and length of the proposed private means of access to OS Field No. 7264 provided for in the 1977 Order, and
- f. to alter the proposed classification of the proposed new highways lettered 'A' and 'B' (as proposed to be varied) described in a. above from 'Principal' to 'Classified' and to classify the proposed New Highway lettered 'C' on the map accompanying this Order (as proposed to be varied) as a Classified Board Road.
