

SHEPWAY DISTRICT COUNCIL

The District of Shepway (Various Roads, Hythe) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulation Orders) Order 1975 (Amendment) (No. 1) Order 1980.

Notice is hereby given that the District Council of Shepway in pursuance of arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Kent County Council, propose to make an Order under sections 1(1), (2) and (3) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to amend the District of Shepway (Various Roads, Hythe) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulation Orders) Order, 1975 as follows.

(i) By the deletion from Schedule 5 (One way streets) to the said Order of the following length of road:

Mount Street, from its junction with Prospect Road to its junction with High Street—south to north;

(ii) by the inclusion in Schedule 5 (One way streets) to the said Order of the following length of road:

Mount Street, from a point 75 metres south of its junction with High Street to its junction with High Street—south to north.

HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

The County Council of Cambridgeshire (Horseheath Bypass Classified Road) (Side Roads) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Cambridgeshire hereby give notice that they have made, and submitted to the Minister of Transport for confirmation, an Order under Sections 1 and 3 of the Highways Act 1971 for authorising the Council:

- (a) to carry out improvements to the highways known as the Barton Seagrave to Harwich Road A604 and Howards Lane at Horseheath in the County of Cambridgeshire,
- (b) to stop up the highways known as Howards Lane, Horseheath, Public Footpath No. 11 (Horseheath), Public Footpath No. 14 (Horseheath) and Public Footpath No. 15 (Horseheath) in each case between the boundaries of the proposed Horseheath Bypass,
- (c) to stop up private means of access running south and east from the A604 in O.S. Enclosure Nos. 0004, 0006 and 8211 and east/west in O.S. Enclosure No. 0006 (O.S. Sheet TL 6047/6147, 1959 Edition), and
- (d) to provide new private means of access from Howards Lane (as improved) north of the proposed Horseheath Bypass into O.S. Enclosure No. 78 (O.S. Sheets Cambs. LV.16 1903 Edition and LV.13, 1926 Edition), from the north side of the proposed Horseheath Bypass into O.S. Enclosure No. 157 (O.S. Sheet Cambs. LV.12, 1926 Edition), from the south side of the proposed Horseheath Bypass into O.S. Enclosure No. 152 (O.S. Sheet Cambs. LV.13, 1926 Edition), and from the south side of the proposed Horseheath Bypass into O.S. Enclosure No. 161 (O.S. Sheet Cambs. LV.13, 1926 Edition).
