

south of the north-eastern corner of the said parcel in a northerly direction for about 18 metres, thence in a westerly direction for about 374 metres, thence in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 478 metres and thence in a westerly direction for 212 metres to rejoin the existing footpath.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the Borough Secretary's Office, Council Offices, Swanspool, Wellingborough during normal office hours.

Any representation or objection in respect of the Order may be sent in writing to the Borough Secretary before 10th April, 1980 and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the Borough Council of Wellingborough may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State any representations and objections which

have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.
