(2) The Nottinghamshire County Council (Queens Drive Diversion, The Meadows, Nottingham) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1981: (a) Vehicles (except buses) will be prohibited from proceeding in part of Queens Drive Diversion, Nottingham, north-bound carriageway, near-side lane; (b) vehicles shall proceed in a north to south
