CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

The Borough of Rossendale No. 5 Smoke Control Order 1981 (Edgeside)

Notice is hereby given that Rossendale Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act, as amended, propose to make an Order entitled the Borough of Rossendale No. 5 Smoke Control Order 1981, the effect of which will be to declare the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area.

Subject to the conditions and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

The Order when made will not come into operation before 1st November 1982.

Copies of the proposed Order and of the map referred to therein together with a list showing the properties affected may be inspected free of charge at the Secretary's Department, Town Hall, Rawtenstall, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday to Friday, during the period of 7 weeks from 11th April 1981.
