The District Council of Chichester (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the Council propose to make an Order under section 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

- (a) introduce new Regulations and vary the present Regulations governing the use of off-street parking places specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- (b) vary the charges made for the use of parking places in accordance with the particulars described in Schedule 2;
- (c) introduce charges for the use of the parking place described in Schedule 3;
- (d) provide for payment by means of a pay and display system for the use of the parking places described in Schedule 4;
- (e) introduce an excess charge of £20 (i) on the non-payment of the prescribed charges, (ii) the failure to display a valid season ticket or (iii) the permitting of a vehicle to remain parked for a longer period than that for which payment has been made in various parking places;
- (f) introduce season tickets for the use of parking places as described in Schedule 5.

A copy of the draft Order together with a map showing the location of the parking places and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order is available for inspection at the office of the undersigned and Petworth and Midhurst Area Offices during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing, stating the grounds of objection, to the undersigned by 21st August 1981.
