THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The A5 London-Holyhead Trunk Road (Cerrigydrudion Diversion) Order 198 and

The A5 London-Holyhead Trunk Road (Cerrigydrudion Diversion Side Roads) Order 198

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

(1) an Order under sections 10 and 41 of the Highways Act 1980 providing:

(a) that two lengths of road about 226 metres (247 yards) and 174 metres (190 yards) in length which he proposes to construct at Cerrigydrudion in the County of Clwyd shall become trunk roads as from the date when the above Order comes into operation; and

(2) an Order under sections 12, 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him:

(a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,

(b) to stop up highways,

(c) to construct new highways,

(d) to stop up private means of access to premises; and

(e) to provide new means of access to premises, all at Cerrigydrudion aforesaid, and providing for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Clwyd as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.

The Secretary of State for Wales also gives notice that the draft Orders published under sections 7 and 9 of the Highways Act 1959 on 21st September 1976 are hereby withdrawn.

Copies of the draft Orders and of the relevant plans may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 7th July 1983 until 18th August 1983 or within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, whichever period shall expire later at the Welsh Office, Transport and Highways Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL and at the offices of Clwyd County Council, Shire Hall, Mold, Clwyd and at Cerrigydrudion Post Office, Cerrigydrudion, Clwyd.

Any person may not later than 18th August 1983 or within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, if such period shall expire later, object to the making of the Orders by notice to the Secretary of State for Wales at the Welsh Office, Transport and Highways Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL quoting ref. WR11/1/25 and stating the grounds of objection. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of grounds of objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.

The Trunk Road (A40 and A483) (Various Roads, Llandeilo) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1983.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended, which shall come into operation on 25th July 1983. The effect of the Order is to prohibit the waiting of any vehicle between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m., for more than 30 minutes in any period of 1 hour, on the side of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.

Exceptions in the Order will permit waiting for the following purposes:

(a) picking up or setting down passengers;

(b) loading or unloading goods;

(c) building, industrial or demolition operations; and
