Borough of Macclesfield (Coare Street, Macclesfield) (Prohibition of Driving) Order

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Cheshire County Council the Macclesfield Borough Council propose to make the above Orders in accordance with the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. The effect of the Orders which will be to make perma-

nent the temporary ones currently in force will be as follows:

Borough of Macclesfield (Coare Street, Macclesfield) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order

To revoke the waiting restrictions which prohibited waiting at any time on both sides of Coare Street and to substitute a prohibition of waiting Order on the north side of the road only for its entire length between 8 a.m. and

6 p.m., Monday to Saturday inclusive.

Exemptions will include in respect of the loading and unloading of goods, the supply of gas, water and electricity, building or demolition operations, the setting down and picking up of passengers and disabled drivers vehicles.

# Borough of Macclesfield (Coare Street, Macclesfield) (Prohibition of Driving) Order

To prohibit the driving of motor vehicles in either direction along Coare Street between its junction with Beech Lane and its junction with Westminster Road.

Exemptions will include in respect of the delivery of and collection of goods to or from premises situated on or adjacent to Coare Street, including premises situated on or adjacent to Brock Street, Pownall Street, Tunnicliffe Street, Pearle Street, New Hall Street, Northgate Avenue, Road and Brynton Close, the supply of gas water Brynton Road and Brynton Close, the supply of gas, water and electricity and stage carriage vehicles.
