NOTICE OF PROPOSALS FOR VARYING A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Calf Hey, Ogdens and Holden Wood Reservoirs

Notice is hereby given that the North West Water Authority in pursuance of section 42 of the above Act have formulated proposals for varying the Licence (Serial Number 25/69/1/165) to abstract water from the Calf Hey and Ogden Reservoirs and from the Musbury Brook all in the Borough of Rossendale at National Grid Reference: SD 765225, SD 755224 and SD 766212 respectively.

The proposed variation is that the said licence shall be varied so as to permit also abstraction of water from the Holden Wood Reservoir at National Grid Reference SD 774222. The amount of water to be abstracted from the Holden Wood Reservoir shall not be more than either of the following:

- (i) 9 million gallons of water in any one week commencing on Sunday.
- (ii) 1.575 million gallons in any one day of 24 hours commencing at midnight.

A copy of the proposals and of any map, plan or other document prepared in connection with them may be inspected free of charge at Dawson House, Liverpool Road, Great Sankey, Warrington, and at Oakland House, Talbot Road, Old Trafford, Manchester, at all reasonable hours during the period beginning on 23rd January 1984 and ending on 20th February 1984.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

AVON COUNTY COUNCIL

*County of Avon (Portishead Area, District of Woodspring)
(General Traffic Regulation) Order 1984*

Notice is hereby given that on 17th January 1984, the County Council of Avon made an Order under sections 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to:

- (1) prohibit any vehicle waiting at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- (2) prohibit any vehicle waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday (inclusive), in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;
- (3) prohibit any vehicle waiting for more than 1 hour in any 2 hourly period between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday (inclusive), in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice;
- (4) impose one-way traffic working on the length of road specified in Schedule 4 to this notice;
- (5) prohibit any motor vehicle from entering or proceeding along the lengths of road specified in Schedule 5 to this notice;
- (6) revoke current traffic regulations in favour of the above prohibitions and restrictions although some lengths of roads will be subject to identical prohibitions and restrictions.

The Order will come into operation on 30th January 1984, and a copy thereof together with a map may be inspected at the under-mentioned offices (sixth floor) during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks after the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Avon Way, north side, from 85 metres (93 yards) east of West Hill to 16 metres (18 yards) east of Channel View Crescent.

Channel View Crescent, both sides, from Avon Way for 10 metres (11 yards).

Coombe Road, south side, from 48 metres (52 yards) west of High Street for 22 metres (24 yards) westwards.

Ferndale Road

Both sides, from Slade Road for 5 metres (6 yards).

South side, from 15 metres (16 yards) west of High Street for 20 metres (22 yards) westwards.

High Street

West side:

(a) from 39 metres (43 yards) south of Wyndham Way for 22 metres (24 yards) southwards;

(b) from 10 metres (11 yards) north of Combe Road for 14 metres (15 yards) south of Combe Road;

(c) from 10 metres (11 yards) north of Stoke Road to 10 metres (11 yards) south of Stoke Road;

(d) from 10 metres (11 yards) north of Roath Road to 10 metres (11 yards) south of Roath Road.

East side:

(a) from 39 metres (43 yards) south of Wyndham Way for 86 metres (94 yards) southwards;

(b) from 44 metres (48 yards) north of Albert Road for 40 metres (44 yards) northwards;

(c) from 12 metres (13 yards) north of Albert Road to 12 metres (13 yards) south of Albert Road.

North side, the whole length.
