west side, from a point 30 metres north of its junction with Castle Lane to its junction with Ellacombe Road (i.e., extended across the frontage of No. 35); west side, from a point 25 metres south of its junction with Castle Lane southwards to the boundary of Nos. 13-15 (i.e. extended across the frontage of No. 21).

The existing no waiting restrictions in Baymount, Paignton, west side, from a point 15 metres south of its junction with Blatchcombe Road southwards for a distance of 20 metres will be revoked.

Exceptions in the Orders permit waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading, boarding and alighting, Post Office services, maintenance of the road, supply of gas, water and electricity, pursuance of statutory powers or duties, taking in petrol, oil or air from a garage. The

statutory exemptions for disabled persons' vehicles are included.

Copies of the Orders and of the maps showing the affected lengths of road, together with statements of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders, may be inspected during the usual office hours, Monday to Friday, at the offices of the Town Clerk and Chief Executive Officer, Borough of Torbay, Town Hall, Torquay, or at Oldway, Paignton, or at the address given below.

If you wish to object to the proposed Orders, you must send the grounds for your objection in writing to the undersigned by 9th March 1984.

PROPOSED OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES ORDER

The North Devon (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1984

Notice is hereby given that North Devon District Council proposes to make an Order under section 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and the Local Government Act 1972 to control the use of the parking places named in the Schedule to this notice which shows the class of vehicle, the days and times of operation, the maximum period for waiting and the scale of charges proposed for each parking place.

The Order will specify the conditions under which the parking places may be used. Full details are contained in the draft Order which together with maps showing the locations of the parking places may be seen at Room 311, Civic Centre, Barnstaple during normal office hours.

If anyone wishes to object to this Order, the objection, with the grounds for making it should be made in writing to the undersigned not later than 9th March 1984.

SCHEDULE

In this Schedule:

(a) The permitted classes of vehicles are as follows:

- (i) Solo motor cycles;
- (ii) Registered disabled vehicles;
- (iii) Motor cars;
- (iv) Motor cycle combinations;
- (v) Motor vehicles not exceeding 30 cwt. unladen weight;
- (vi) Trailers and caravans;
- (vii) Motor vehicles exceeding 30 cwt. unladen weight;
- (viii) Coaches.

(b) The permitted classes of vehicles must wait wholly within a parking bay set aside for that class of vehicle.

(c) The period of operation of the parking place is that which appears in column 5 save that the Council may at its discretion suspend the operation of this Order in relation to the whole or any part of any parking place at any time and for whatever purpose it deems fit. This is without prejudice to the Council's right under Clause 16 of the Order to close the parking place or one or more parking bays within the parking place.
