For deposits made under earlier Prospectuses (Series 4 and 5) which reach the second or fourth anniversary of the deposits, as applicable, in accordance with the terms and conditions set out therein: 9½ per cent if the deposit is applied in payment of a scheduled liability, and 7 per cent if the deposit is withdrawn for cash.
