Notice is hereby given that the District Council of West Lancashire (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Lancashire in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3) and 4 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, propose to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting on the following lengths of road at Ormskirk:

- (a) Dyers Lane, on its southern side, for a distance of 14 metres in a westerly direction from its junction with Ryburn Road.
- (b) Ryburn Road, on its western side, for a distance of 10 metres in a south-westerly direction from its junction with Dyers Lane.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait on the lengths of road specified above for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein or if the vehicle is a disabled person's vehicle vehicle is a disabled person's vehicle.
