The Trunk Road (A40) (Crickhowell, Powys) (Restricted Roads) Order 1985

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under sections 82 and 83 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will come into operation on 19th August 1985

The effect of the Order is that no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h in that length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice
