BARNESLEY METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

CLEAN AIR ACT 1956 (AS AMENDED BY THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT, PLANNING AND LAND ACT 1980)

The Proposed Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council (Athersley South) Smoke Control Order No. 45, 1986

Notice is hereby given that the Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 (as amended by the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980) intend to make an Order entitled *The Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council (Athersley South) Smoke Control Order No. 45, 1986* declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area. Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of subsection (4) of section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, if on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £400 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If made the Order will not come into operation before 1st November 1988, or before a later date determined by the Council. Copies of the proposed Order and the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Barnsley, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from 20th June 1986.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the proposed Order may by notice to the Director of Consumer and Environmental Services, Town Hall, Barnsley, object to the making of the Order.
