Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way over lengths of City Footpaths at Great Linford, Milton Keynes

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the New Towns Act 1981, propose to make an Order extinguishing the public rights of way over the following routes shown by continuous thick black lines on the map hereinafter referred to:

"That length of the city footpath at Great Linford starting at a point marked "A" on the map (approximately 12 metres south-east of number 26 Gibbwin, Great Linford) and running in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 17 metres to a point marked "A1" (at its junction with Malins Gate)".

"That length of the city footpath at Great Linford starting at a point marked "B" on the map (approximately 7 metres north of Unit 9 at the Great Linford local centre) and running in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 46 metres to a point marked "B1" (at its junction with Malins Gate)".

"That length of the city footpath at Great Linford starting at the point marked "X" on the map (at the south side of Malins Gate approximately 15 metres west of St. Leger Drive) and running in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 80 metres to a point marked "Y" (at the entrance to the St. Leger Court Car Park off St. Leger Drive)".
