

(3) The undermentioned streets will be restricted to a traffic flow in the direction indicated.

Liverpool Road (Hornby Road to Leamington Road), south to north.

Side street off *Melrose Avenue* (adjacent to property No. 26) west to east.

(4) Existing no waiting restrictions in the following length of road will be revoked:

Back Reads Road (from a point 40 metres east of Stanley Road for a distance of 67 metres in an easterly direction), north side.

(5) Existing waiting restrictions in the following length of road will be revoked:

Leeds Road (Leicester Road to 9 metres west of Whitegate Drive), north side.
