ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Trunk Road (A487) (Furnace, Dyfed) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to prohibit (with certain exceptions) the waiting of any vehicle at any time in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The Trunk Road (A487) (Furnace Bridge, Dyfed) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1989 which imposes similar restrictions on the south-western continuous length of the road, will be revoked and its provisions re-enacted by the proposed Order.
