## The Borough of Broxbourne (Parking of Goods and Commercial Vehicles) Order 1990

Notice is hereby given that on 3rd September 1990 the Council of the Borough of Broxbourne, pursuant to arrangements made with the Hertfordshire County Council under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which revokes the existing Orders prohibiting the waiting at any time of goods and commercial vehicles exceeding 30 cwt. unladen weight in the Hoddesdon, Hailey and Rye Park areas, and introduces a prohibition on waiting at any time of goods and commercial vehicles exceeding 5 tonnes gross laden weight in the roads as set out in the Schedule hereto.

The Order is necessary to comply with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981 which provides that the imperial-based signs associated with the lorry parking ban in Hoddesdon, Hailey and Rye House must be replaced with metricbased signs. The change involves a transition from the 30 cwt. actual weight to the corresponding 5 tonnes maximum gross weight as specified in Part V of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1989.

This Order will come into operation on 10th September 1990.

The Order contains exemptions to permit waiting for the purpose of boarding or alighting from a vehicle, loading or unloading, building or demolition works, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the services therein, emergency services and the pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

A copy of the Order may be inspected at the offices of the undersigned between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks from 7th September 1990, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
