UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT 1923

A Statute made by the Governing Body of Saint Anne's College, in the University of Oxford on 24th April 1991, amending Statutes I, IV, VI and XVI has been submitted for the approval of Her Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923.

The purposes of the Statute are to modify provisions concerning eligibility for membership and to reduce the quorum for meetings of the Governing Body and to declare the adoption of an Equal Opportunity Policy. (15 SI)
