The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Securities Office, Bank of England, Threadneedle Street, on Friday, 5th July 1991, at 1 p.m. for sterling Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act 1877 and the National Loans Act 1968, to the amount of £200,000,000 for Bills due 63 days after date, £500,000,000 for Bills due 91 days after date and £200,000,000 for Bills due 182 days after

- 2. The Bills will be in amounts of £5,000, £10,000, £25,000, £50,000, £100,000, £250,000 or £1,000,000. They will be dated at the option of the Tenderer on any business day from Monday, 8th July 1991 to Friday, 12th July 1991, inclusive.
 - 3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.
- 4. Each Tender must be for an amount not less than £50,000 and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated and the net amount per cent (being a multiple of half of one penny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills different dates and different tentors.
- 5. Notification will be sent on the day of the Tender to the persons whose Tenders are accepted in whole or in part.
