**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990** 

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of a length of Pytchley Road, Northamptonshire, to enable development consisting of motor trade premises to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Whitworths Motor Holdings Ltd. by Kettering Borough Council under Part III of the said Act.

The proposed Order will require the provision of a new highway maintainable at the public expense, for which the highway authority
