The Wigan Borough (Belmont Street, Pemberton, Wigan) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1991

The Wigan Borough (Cross Street, Standish) (Restriction of Waiting Order 1991

The Wigan Borough (Market Street/Chapel Street, Hindley) (One-way Working) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that the Wigan Borough Council in exercise of the powers under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders.

The effect of each Order will be as follows:

1. *Belmont Street, Pemberton*, to prohibit driving at the junction of Belmont Street and Fleet Street, Pemberton from the easterly kerb-line of Fleet Street for a distance of 5 metres in an easterly direction.
2. *Cross Street, Standish*, to introduce waiting restrictions to apply between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday in the lay-by on the north-west side of Cross Street, Standish.
3. *Market Street/Chapel Street, Hindley*, to introduce one-way working in the following roads:
 - (i) Access road between Nos. 77 and 79 Market Street in a south-easterly direction for 45 metres and then south-westerly to the south-eastern end of Chapel Street.
 - (ii) Chapel Street in a north-westerly direction.

With regard to the waiting restrictions there will be limited exceptions permitting vehicles to wait:

- (a) to enable people to board and alight;
- (b) for the purpose of building and similar operations, removing obstructions to traffic, road works and works by statutory undertakers;
- (c) for local authority, North West Water Ltd. and Post Office purposes;
- (d) if the vehicles are fire service or police vehicles or ambulances;
- (e) to take on fuel, water or air at any garage; or
- (f) for the delivery or collection of goods and for loading or unloading.

Copies of the proposed Orders, and of the relevant maps, and of statements of the reasons for proposing to make the Orders and of the Orders to be revoked, may be inspected at the New Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan, between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on any day from Monday to Friday.

Any objection to the Order must be made in writing and specify the grounds thereof and must be made to the Borough Solicitor, New Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan not later than 23rd August 1991.

The Wigan Borough (Station Avenue, Orrell, Wigan) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1991

The Wigan Borough (St. Stephen's Avenue, Whelley, Wigan) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that the Wigan Borough Council in exercise of the powers under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders.

The effect of each Order will be as follows:

1. *Station Avenue, Orrell*, to introduce waiting restrictions to apply to at all times on the north side of Station Avenue, Orrell, from a point 10 metres west of Church Street for a distance of 47 metres in a westerly direction.
2. *St. Stephen's Avenue, Whelley*, to impose waiting restrictions to apply at all times on the northside of St. Stephen's Avenue, Whelley, from a point 18 metres east of Whelley to Elworthy Grove.

Copies of the proposed Orders, and of the relevant maps, may be inspected at the New Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan, between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on any day from Monday to Friday.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the ground:

- (b) that any requirement of the said section 1, or of Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act, or of any regulations made under the said Part III of Schedule 9, has not been complied with,

NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Council of the County of North Yorkshire (Harrogate) (Traffic Management) (Amendment No. 17) Order 1991
