- (ii) To increase the maximum period for which vehicles may wait in the short stay parking from two to three hours, at the following parking places: New Road Car Park, Crowborough, Vicarage Field Car Park, Hailsham, The Laurels Car Park, Hailsham, Victoria Road Car Park, Hailsham, Mill Road Car Park, Waldron, Station Road (West) Car Park, Waldron, Regency Court (South) Car Park, Uckfield and Regency Court (North) Car Park, Uckfield.
- (c) To enable provision of parking bays for Disabled Badge holders at the following parking places: Church Marks Lane Car Park, East Hoathly, The Laurels Car Park, Hailsham and Station Road (West) Car Park, Waldron.
- (d) To make an additional four parking places set out in the Notice Schedule hereto subject to the provisions of the 1990 Order and to delete the parking place at Gateways Supermarket Car Park, Heathfield from the Schedule and maps to the 1990 Order.
- (e) To make minor and consequential amendments to the Schedule and maps to the 1990 Order.
