#### The Trunk Road (A470) (Erwood, Powys) (Restricted Roads) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under sections 82 and 83 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to restrict the driving of motor vehicles to a speed not exceeding 30 m.p.h. in the length of trunk road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice; and also to revoke and re-enact the provisions of the Trunk Road (Erwood, Powys) (Restricted Roads) Order 1981 which presently imposes a 30 m.p.h. speed limit on the length of trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

A copy of the draft Order and Order being revoked, together with a plan and statement of reasons for making the Order, may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Brecknock Borough Council, Strand Hall, Strand Street, Builth Wells, Powys. Objections, specifying the grounds on which they are made, and quoting ref. ZC 510-6-6-5, must be sent in writing to the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL by 20th February 1992.
