TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-Up of Highways (County of Derbyshire) (No. 2) Order 1992" authorising the stopping-up of an irregularly shaped area of highway measuring 148 square metres. It is situated on the south-western side of St. Peter's Street, Derby, at its junction with London Road and is locally known as "The Spot".
