#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act, which will authorise the stopping up of part of High Cross at Froxfield in the county of Hampshire.

If the Order is made, the stopping up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to Sprinks Else and Associates for Brymarsh Ltd. by East Hampshire District Council on 9th June 1992 under Ref. F31450/001.

The proposed Order will provide that the stopping up must not be carried out until Brymarsh Ltd. has provided the new layby and footpath.

Copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at all reasonable hours during the 28 days commencing on 29th July 1992 at the East Hampshire District Council Offices, Penns Place, Durford Road, Petersfield, and may be obtained free of charge from the Department of Transport (quoting Ref. MSE 5057/0/0/35/1/87) at the address below.

During the above-mentioned period of 28 days anyone may object to the making of the Order by writing to the Secretary of State, quoting Ref. MSE 5057/0/0/35/1/87, and addressing their objection to The Director, South East Network Management Division, Department of Transport, Senet House, Station Road, Dorking, Surrey RH4 1HJ. In the preparation of an objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection may be communicated to the applicant and other people who may be affected by it.
