REDEMPTION OF 9 PER CENT TREASURY LOAN, 1992 TO 1996

Registered Stock

Proposed Works on Blacksmith's Common, Ilketshall St. Andrew, Suffolk

Notice is hereby given that an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for the Environment will attend at the Village Hall, Ilketshall St. Andrew, Beccles, Suffolk, on Tuesday, 17th November 1992, to hold a public local inquiry into proposals by Eastern Electricity plc to construct an electricity sub-station, and an access road thereto, at Barsham. An application for consent under section 194 of the Law of Property Act 1925, to construct part of the access road on 280 square metres or thereabouts of Blacksmith's Common, will be considered at that inquiry.

The inquiry, which is expected to last some days, will begin at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, 17th November 1992 and will include an evening session at 7 p.m. on Thursday, 26th November 1992.

It is desirable that all persons interested should attend the inquiry.
