The Borough of Trafford (Victoria Road, Stretford) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order

Notice is hereby given that on 12th March 1993, the Trafford Borough Council, made the above-named Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order is to prohibit waiting at anytime as follows:

From:

Victoria Road:

West side, from the southern kerb edge of Derbyshire Lane, for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction.

East side, from the southern kerb edge of Derbyshire Lane, to the northern kerb edge of School Road.

To:

Victoria Road:

West side, from its junction with Derbyshire Lane to its junction with School Road.

East side:

From 10 metres south of the southerly kerb-line of Pritchard Street to 10 metres north of the northerly kerb-line of Pritchard Street to 10 metres north of the northerly kerb-line of Pritchard Street. From the northerly kerb-line of School Road for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

From the southerly kerb-line of Derbyshire Lane for a distance of 15 metres.

The Order will come into operation on 12th March 1993, and a copy, together with a map showing the lengths of road which it relates may be inspected in the Information Office, Trafford Town Hall, Talbot Road, Stretford between the hours of 8.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m., Monday to Friday.

No Waiting at Anytime

Warwick Road North:

The easterly side, from a point 50 metres from the northerly kerb-line of Chester Road, to the southerly kerb-line of Trafford Park Road.

The westerly side, from a point 95 metres from the northerly kerb-line of Chester Road, to the southerly kerb-line of Trafford Park Road.

Limited Waiting Monday to Friday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. for One Hour, Return Prohibited within One Hour

Warwick Road North, the westerly side, from a point 55 metres north of the northerly kerb-line of Chester Road for a distance of 40 metres in a northerly direction.

Railway Road, the south side from a point 30 metres east of Partridge Street for a distance of 15 metres in an easterly direction.

The proposal revokes the Borough of Trafford (Warwick Road and Warwick Road North, Stretford) (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading/Unloading) Order 1979 which replaced the identical titled order dated 1978 which was not revoked and now requires revocation.

It also revokes Schedule 2 of the Borough of Trafford (Railway Road, Stretford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979 and that part of the Schedule of the Borough of Stretford (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1968 which applies to Warwick Road North.
