THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The County Council of Gwent (Tredegar Bypass, Phase 1 Route A4048 Classified Road) (Side Roads) (Variation) Order 1993

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has confirmed the above Order which was made by the County Council of Gwent under sections 14, 125 and 326 of the Highways Act 1980 and which, as confirmed, authorises the Council:

- (a) to amend the proposed highway improvement at Heathfield Bridge, at the southern most extremity of the scheme, from a priority junction to a roundabout;
- (b) to amend the proposed stopping-up of the private means of access from the classified road to Pump House and provide new means of access from the classified road to Mill Farm and to land used by British Coal;
- (c) to amend the proposed highway improvement at the junction of the proposed Town Centre Link Road with Commercial Street/Church Street and Stockton Way from a roundabout to a signal controlled junction;
- (d) to delete the proposed pedestrian underpass linking St. George's Court with the town centre and make provision for pedestrians at the signal controlled junction.

Copies of the Order, as confirmed, and of the relevant plan may be inspected free of charge, at all reasonable hours at the offices of Gwent Councy Council, County Hall, Cwmbran; Blaenau, Gwent Borough Council, Civic Centre, Ebbw Vale, Gwent; Tredegar Town Council, Bedwellty House, Tredegar, Gwent and at the Welsh Office, Legal Group, Cardiff.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks of 10th August 1993, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981: SECTION 29

Sawston Hall Meadows (Cambridgeshire) Nature Conservation Order 1992

Notice is hereby given under paragraph 6 of Schedule 11 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, that the Secretary of State having considered the objectives duly made in respect of the abovenamed Order and the report of the person appointed to hold a hearing has decided to take no action to amend or revoke it. In consequence the Order which took effect on 12th November 1992, will continue in effect.

The general effect of the Order is to impose restrictions on the carrying out of certain operations specified in the Order on land described in the Order (which is an area of some 2 hectares situated within the Sawston Hall Meadows Site of Special Scientific Interest, Cambridgeshire, the exact delineation of which is set out on the plan referred to in the Order).

Copies of the Order and map referred to in it and of this notice have been deposited at the offices of the South Cambridgeshire District Council, South Cambridgeshire Hall, 9-11 Hills Road, Cambridge CB2 1PS. They may be seen free of charge at all reasonable hours.

Any person who is aggrieved by the Order and desires to question its validity on the grounds that it is not within the powers of section 29 of the said Act of 1981, or that any of the requirements of Schedule 11 to that Act had not been complied with in relation to it
