The Borough of Gateshead (Coldwell Lane, Felling) (Revocation of Waiting Restrictions) Order 1993

Notice is hereby given that on 14th December 1993, the Borough Council of Gateshead made an Order under sections 1, 2, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, which comes into operation on 19th December 1993, will be to remove the existing 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. (Monday to Saturday) waiting restrictions on the west side of Coldwell Lane, Felling, between its junctions with Hopper Road and Victoria Avenue.

The Borough Council of Gateshead (Queen Elizabeth Avenue, Gateshead) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1994

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the following lengths of Queen Elizabeth Avenue, Gateshead:

- (a) east side from its junction with Old Durham Road north-eastwards for 50 metres;
- (b) east side from a point 90 metres north-east of its junction with Old Durham Road north-eastwards for 95 metres;
- (c) west side from its junction with Old Durham Road north-eastwards for 40 metres;
- (d) west side from a point 125 metres north-east of its junction with Old Durham Road north-eastwards for 65 metres.

Normal exemptions would apply including those for disabled persons vehicles.
