M40 Motorway Widening (Junctions 1A to 3) Supplementary Side Roads Order 199

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 18 of the Highways Act 1980, in relation to the part of the M40 Motorway situated between junctions 1A and 3 in the County of Buckinghamshire, which will
