- (a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin (measured as the average of a sample of not more than one 'kilogramme of the coin) of 0.095 grammes;
- (b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.1 millimetres per coin; and
- (c) a variation from the said standard composition of two per centum copper, three-quarters per centum nickel and two per centum zinc.

(3) The said nickel-brass coin may contain impurities of 0.75 of one per centum.

(4) The said nickel-brass coin shall be legal tender for payment of any amount in any part of Our United Kingdom.

5. The composition of the standard trial plates to be used for determining the justness of the said nickel-brass coins shall be pure copper, pure nickel and pure zinc.

DESIGN FOR THE COINS

6. The design for the said gold, siver and nickel-brass coins shall be as follows:

For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "ELIZABETH.II.DEI.GRATIA.REGINA.F.D" and the words "TWO POUNDS", and for the reverse the fiftheth anniversary symbol of the United Nations and a fanning pattern of flags, with the inscription "NATIONS UNITED FOR PEACE" above and the dates "1945-1995" below. The coins shall have a graining upon the edge.

7. This Proclamation shall come into force on the ninth day of February One thousand nine hundred and ninety-five.
