TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Stopping-up of Highways (Ridgeway, Chapel Lane, Chirk, Clwyd) Order 1996

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 to authorise the stopping-up of the highway described in Schedule 1 to this Notice.

The stopping-up is authorised only in order to enable the development described in Schedule 2 to this notice to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to P. Williams by Glyndwr District Council on 29th June 1994 under ref. 4/14118.

Copies of the made Order and the annexed plan may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Chirk Town Council, Parish Hall, Holyhead Road, Chirk, or may be obtained free of charge from Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Phase 1, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, (quoting ref. ZC 510-5-1-30).

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained therein, on the grounds:

(a) that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990; or

(b) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act,

he may, within 6 weeks of 9th February 1996, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULE 1

(All measurements are approximate)

The highway to be stopped up is situtated immediately to the south and east of the footway at the junction of Chapel Lane and Holyhead Road, near Ridgeway, at Chirk in the County of Clwyd. It is shown by zebra hatching on the annexed plan and comprises an area of highway land, 3 metres in width, which extends for a distance of 14 metres in an easterly direction and 5.75 metres in a southerly direction.
