### DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of Fawcett Close, Woodhouse Close Estate, Bishop Auckland, County Durham.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to Browne, Smith Baker & Partners acting as agents for the Bradford & Northern Housing Association by Wear Valley District Council on 6th December 1995 under ref. 3/95/592.

The proposed Order will require improvements of highway at Fawcett Close, which will be maintainable at the public expense for which the District Council will be the local highway authority.

The proposed Order will provide that the stopping-up must not be carried out until improvements have been completed, and that highway shall be a highway maintainable at the public expense for which the District Council will be the local highway authority.

Copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at all reasonable hours during 28 days commencing on 27th August 1996 at the offices of Planning Department, Wear Valley District Council, Civic Centre, Crook, County Durham DL15 9ES, and may be obtained free of charge from the Department of Transport (quoting Ref. DN5053/35/1/297) at the address stated below.

Any person may object to the making of the proposed Order within the period of 28 days commencing on 27th August 1996 by notice to the Secretary of State for Transport, quoting the above reference, at the office of the Director Environment and Transport, Government Office for the North East, Wellbar House, Gallowgate, Newcastle upon Tyne NE1 4TD.

In preparing an objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of it may be imparted to other persons who may be affected by it and that those persons may wish to communicate with the objector about it.
