TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Stopping-up of Highways (Wroughton Place, Ely, Cardiff) Order 1997

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, to authorise the stopping-up of the length of highway described in Schedule I to this notice.

The stopping-up is authorised only in order to enable the development described in Schedule 2 to this notice to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted by the County Council of the City and County of Cardiff on 3rd January 1997, under reference 96/01746/R. The Order shall cease to have effect upon the cessation of this planning permission.

Copies of the Order and the deposited plan may be inspected, free of charge, during normal office hours, at the offices of the County Council of the City and County of Cardiff, Planning Department, Wood Street, Cardiff, or may be obtained, free of charge, from the Welsh Office Highways Directorate, RA3, Cathays Park, Cardiff CFI 3NQ (quoting reference ZC 510-5-71-5).

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, or that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of the Act, he may, within 6 weeks of 19th May 1997, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULE 1

(all distances are approximate)

The area of highway to be stopped up is at Wroughton Place, Ely in Cardiff. It is shown by zebra hatching on the deposited plan and is a rectangular area of footway which extends from the north-easterly most point of the footways junction with the property known as Unit 5, Wroughton Place, for a distance of $2\cdot3$ metres in a south-westerly direction and is $1\cdot35$ metres in width.

SCHEDULE 2

Development consisting of the construction of emergency exit steps onto footway from a factory/warehouse unit at Unit 5, Wroughton Place, Ely, Cardiff.
