TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Stopping-Up of Highways (Various Roads, Butetown, Cardiff) Order 199

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, to authorise the stopping-up of the highways described in Schedule 1 to this notice.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in Schedule 2 to this notice to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted by the County Council of the City and County of Cardiff, on 12 January 1998, under Ref 94/01987/R. The Order shall cease to have effect upon the cessation of the planning permission.

The Order will require the provision of new highway which will be highway maintainable at the public expense, for which the County Council of the City and County of Cardiff shall be the Highway Authority.

During 28 days from 16th February 1998, copies of the draft Order and the deposited plan may be inspected, free of charge, during normal office hours at the office of Cardiff County Council, County Hall, Atlantic Wharf, Cardiff, or may be obtained, free of charge, from the address below quoting the Welsh Office Ref

Within the above-mentioned period of 28 days any person may, by notice to the Welsh Office Highways Directorate, Cathays Park, Cardiff CF1 3NQ, (quoting Ref ZC510-5-71-15), object to the making of the Order. In the preparation of an objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.

SCHEDULE 1

Description of the Highways to be stopped up under this Order (All measurements are approximate)

The highways to be stopped up are at Butetown in Cardiff and comprise

- 1 areas of highway known as East Canal Wharf comprising
 - (a) a section of carriageway and footway, situated 30 metres south-east of its junction with Custom House Street, extending from the eastern boundary of the eastern footway for a distance of 8 metres with a maximum width of 2 metres and an area of 15 square metres,
