Transport**Road Traffic Acts****Highways Agency****ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984****THE A38 TRUNK ROAD (SALTASH, CORNWALL)
(RESTRICTION AND DERESTRICTION) ORDER 2003**

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 82(2), 83(1) and 84(1) and (2) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A38 trunk road at Saltash, in the district of Caradon in the county of Cornwall.

The effect of the Order would be to:

(a) impose a 30 mph speed limit on the A38 trunk road at Saltash, through and adjacent to Saltash tunnel, from a point 156 metres north-west of the Tamar Bridge western tower to a point 199 metres north-west of the west portal of Saltash tunnel on the south-east bound carriageway and a point 76 metres north-west of the west portal of Saltash tunnel on the north-west bound carriageway;

(b) to derestrict both carriageways of the A38 trunk road at and north of South Pill junction, Saltash, from a point 274 metres north-west of the west portal of Saltash tunnel to the end of the proposed 30 mph speed limit (199/76 metres north-west of the west portal of Saltash tunnel) as described at (a) above.

The Order would revoke an existing Order imposing a 50 mph speed limit on the A38 trunk road through and on the approaches to Saltash tunnel.

A copy of the draft Order, of a plan illustrating the proposals, a copy of the existing Order to be revoked and a statement explaining why the Secretary of State proposes to make the Order may be inspected during office hours at the offices of Saltash Town Council, 17 Lower Fore Street, Saltash and the offices of Caradon District Council, Luxstowe House, Liskeard, Cornwall.
