### Road Traffic Acts

#### *London Borough of Brent*

#### THE BRENT (VARIOUS ROADS) (NO 3) EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC ORDER 2004

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Brent on 28 June 2004 made the above-mentioned Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of, and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to, the Local Government Act 1985.

2. The general effect of the Order will be to:

(A) prohibit all vehicles from being in:

(i) the bus lane lying within or adjacent the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice and between the south-western kerblines of that length of road and a longitudinal single white line marked on the carriageway of that length of road, between 7.00 am and 7.00 pm throughout the week;

(ii) the prohibition will not apply to:
