ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
THE A12 TRUNK ROAD (M25 BRENTWOOD,
ESSEX—IPSWICH, SUFFOLK) (24 HOURS CLEARWAY)
ORDER 200

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and 4(1) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A12 Trunk Road in Essex and Suffolk.

The effect of the Order would be to prohibit any vehicle from waiting at any time on the A12 Trunk Road, other than a layby, from the centre point of the eastern bridge at Brook Street Interchange at Brentwood, Essex (Junction 28) to its roundabout junction with the A14 at Ipswich Suffolk (Junction 33) including any slip road leading to or from that length of road.

The length of A12 Trunk Road which runs adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A12 at Marks Tey, known as Old London Road, between its junctions with 228 Old London Road and the entrance to Marks Tey Village Hall would be exempt from the prohibition.
