NOBLE STREET—REMOVAL OF METERED PARKING BAYS/ ADDITIONAL WAITING RESTRICTIONS

1. Notice is hereby given that the Common Council of the City of London proposes to make Orders under sections 6 and 45 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The effect of the Orders would be to:

(a) remove the metered parking bays on the east side of Noble Street; and

(b) change the restriction on waiting by vehicles, between Oat Lane and London Wall so that it applies at any time.

3. A copy of the proposed Orders, of the Common Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders and of a plan showing the affected street can be inspected during normal office hours on Monday to Fridays inclusive within a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice was published at the Department of Planning and Transportation, Guildhall, London EC2P 2EJ.
