THE BEXLEY (MISCELLANEOUS PARKING PLACES) TRAFFIC ORDER 1997 (AMENDMENT NO. 38) TRAFFIC ORDER 2009

1. Notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Bexley, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 9 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers hereby gives notice that on the 2nd June, 2009 it made the above named Experimental Traffic Orders. 2. The general effect of the Orders, in amending the provisions of the Bexley (Welling Town Centre) (Parking Places) Traffic Order 2009 and the Bexley (Miscellaneous Parking Places) Traffic Order 1997, will be to extend the hours of operation of four existing metered or 'pay and display' parking places and one existing free limited time parking place in Welling High Street from between the hours of 10am and 4pm
