SAVAGE GARDENS - PEDESTRIAN ZONE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of London propose to make an order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The effect of the order, in association with a street improvement scheme, would be to:

- (a) revoke the existing one way working in Savage Gardens, between Crutched Friars and Pepys Street; and
- (b) prohibit motor vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Savage Gardens.

3. A copy of the proposed order, of the Common Councils statement of reasons for proposing to make the orders and of a plan showing the affected street can be inspected during normal office hours on Monday to Fridays inclusive within a period of 21 days from the date on which this Notice was published at the Department of Planning and Transportation, Guildhall, London, EC2P 2EJ.
