Conflantinople, Navember 16. O.S.

YEfterday the Mufoovite Envoy M. Dafchof fet out from bence on hia Return Home, making a publick Cavalcade through the Town. A Turkifi Aga is gone with him, to compliment the Czar upot the Renewal of the Peace between him and the Port The two French Men of War which brought hither the Turkifh Ambaf fadour who was lately in France, failed from hense aboút to Daga ago, The Ve. retian Bailo has not yet been with the Vizier, to make the Republick's Excufes for what paffed in the Affair of the Dulcig. roto ; but expecto to be called every Day, and he is to carry with him five and twenty Vefts of Velvet, Sattin, and Venetian Brocade, an Prefents for the Grand Signior; which is an additional Expence to the Republick, not Atpulated by the Agreement, but demanded by the Tarks at a conftant Peactite on the like Occafions, to which the Bailo Cubmita. A Perfian Ambaffadour is lately arrived here with a numerous Retinue, chiefly to return the Compliments made by a Turkifh one lately come back from that Country.

Stockbolm, Dec. 6. Tefterday Morning the King and Queen of Sweden went io vie Palace of Carlberg, where his Majefty dined and returned to Town in the Evening. But as foon 2 as there fallo a little Snow, it it laid the King will go and take the Divertion of Hunting for fix or eight Days at the Royal Seat of Grypfholm. The Commiffionere who wese feveral Months ago appointed by the Cbancery here, for examining into and giving Judgment apon the Fifcallo Chargo againt M. Hopken, who was Refident from this Court at that of Vienna, but lefi his Poft and came hither without Permiffion the Clofe of laft Year, have now finihed that Examination, but have not yet pronounced their Sentence.

Lalt Week arrived heré two or three Fmall. Veffela from Fioland, with an Account of the Arrival there of all the Troops fenc. thither fince the Conclufion of the Peace with the, Czar of Mufcovy; for thongh le. veral of the Tranfport Ships were Atranded in 8tormy Weather, yet the Men on Board them had all the good Fortune to efcape $\leq$ But there is yet no Newr of Major-General Yot' Egens who went fromi hence in Ottober latt, to be Govetnour of the Province of Eaf, Bothnia; fo that it is feared he with the \$hip that carried him is loft. Somo Days ago the Crews of fix large Dutob Ships came ovet bither fram Finland, thole Ships baving been caft away neas Helfingfors in their Way home from Pefertbourg and Narta.
Naples, Det. 19. Lat Weelk the Daughter of his Excellency the Prince of Borghefe Viceroy of this Kingdom, fet out from hence for Rome, having been married here the Day before by Proxy to the Duke of Bracciano refiding there.

Lisbon, Dec. 25, N. S. Lefters frons Cadis of the -7th loftant, N. S. bring Advice, that all Commerce was prohibied as that Place with Holland as well at with France: It is generally believed, that this Probibition is occafioned by the groutadefr Report of the Plague having been brought into the Texel by the Datch Man of War faid to belong to Admiral Somelfdyke's Squadron, being the fame Ship which nor long ago caufed fome: Alarm in England. As the Conde de Affumar, late Viceroy of the Rio de Janciro, is preparing to return to Portugal ${ }_{2}$ and in order thereto in obliged to adjuft his Accompts with his Succeffour; it in believed that the Floet from thence may be later than ufual in coming Home, and cannot be expected in this Harboue till the End of the next Morith.
Pari, Gann 14. On the ioth Inttant the Duke of Cbartres was taken ill of a Fever, which lafted almoft 24 Houre, and for which be was bled the next Day; and baving had fince another Fity of it, be was bled for the fecond
fina lat Nighis when his Ferei continued ditl upon bim. The whole Cours is extreamly alarmed at this Accident.
