The King's most Excellent Majesty in Council.

His Majesty in Council was this Day pleased to order, that the Parliament, which stands prorogued to Tuesday the Twenty Seventh of this Instant July, should be further prorogued to Thursday the Twenty Sixth of August next.

This Day His Majesty in Council called for the Council Book, and ordered the Name of William Pulteney, Esq; to be struck out of the List of Privy Councillors.

And His Majesty also further ordered, that the said William Pulteney be put out of all the Commissions of the Peace; and that the several Lord Lieutenants who have given him Deputations, do revoke the same: And the Right Honourable the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, and His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, were directed to give the necessary Orders therein.
