THE MILK (CONTROL) (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER, 1940.

General Licence to persons who sell and produce milk in Northern Ireland.

Pursuant to Article 2 of the abovementioned Order the Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland hereby licences any person to sell milk or to engage in the production of milk for sale in Northern Ireland. This general licence is operative as from 1st April, 1941, and until further notice.
