THE STATUTE LAW COMMITTEE FOR  
NORTHERN IRELAND.  
BY HIS GRACE THE GOVERNOR OF  
NORTHERN IRELAND.  
ABERCORN.

Whereas the Governor of Northern Ireland, by several Instruments given under his hand on the 10th day of March, 1924, and from time to time thereafter, has appointed a Statute Law Committee (hereinafter referred to as "the Statute Law Committee") to make the necessary arrangements for and to superintend—

- (a) the publication of annual volumes, indices and (when necessary) revised editions of the Statutes of Northern Ireland; and
- (b) the editing for publication of annual volumes and indices of the Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland;

and to consider any questions arising in relation to the editing of the Statute Law and Statutory Rules and Orders:

And whereas the present members of the Statute Law Committee were appointed by an Instrument given under the hand of the said Governor on the 27th day of October, 1939, and it is expedient to make certain other appointments to the Statute Law Committee:

Now, therefore, I, James Albert Edward, Duke of Abercorn, Governor of Northern Ireland, do hereby appoint the following
