**THE ENNISKILLEN URBAN DISTRICT (EXTENSION)
ORDER, 1939.**

By an Order dated the 14th March, 1945, the said Ministry has confirmed (with modifications) the Order made by the Council of the Administrative County of Fermanagh on the 12th June, 1939, extending the boundary of the Urban County District of Enniskillen. The extended area will form part of the Urban County District of Enniskillen for all purposes as from the 1st April, 1945.
