URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL WATER.  
APPLICATION FOR PROVISIONAL  
ORDER.

To Alter or Amend Section 102, Sub-section (1) of the Bangor (County Down) Water and Improvement Act, 1905, hereinafter called "The Principal Act," and further as hereafter set out.

NOTICE is hereby given that Application is intended to be made to the Ministry of Home Affairs of Northern Ireland on or before the 23rd day of December next by the Urban District Council of Bangor, County Down (hereinafter called "the Council") for a Provisional Order, pursuant to the Public Health (Ireland) Act, 1878, for all or some of the following, amongst other purposes, namely:—

(1) To amend Section 102, Sub-section (1) of the Principal Act by the substitution therein of the words "fifty-one thousand five hundred pounds" for the words "twenty thousand pounds," and to incorporate the said amendment in the said Act.

(2) To amend Section 102, Sub-section (2) of the Principal Act by the substitution therein of the words "fifteen thousand pounds" for the words "two thousand

pounds," and to incorporate the said amendment in the said Act.

(3) To provide for the payment of the costs and expenses of the Council and the Ministry of Home Affairs of Northern Ireland incurred in respect of the said Application for preparation, making and confirmation of the said Order out of the fund or rate applicable by the Council to defray the expenses incurred by them in the execution of the Public Health (Ireland) Act, 1878 to 1919.

And Notice is hereby further given, that on or before the 30th day of November, instant, a copy of this Notice as published in the Belfast Gazette will be deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Down, at his Office at Downpatrick, and that on or before the same day a copy of this Notice will also be deposited at the Office of the Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, Belfast.

On or before the 23rd day of December next Printed Copies of the Draft Provisional Order will be deposited for public inspection at the Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland at Belfast, and will also be deposited and may be obtained at the price of One Shilling per copy by all persons applying for the same at the Offices of the undersigned.

Any Objections to the Provisional Order which it is intended to urge on the Ministry of Home Affairs of Northern Ireland must be received by them on or before the fifteenth day
