

NOTICE OF CHANGE OF NAME

I, Agnes Baker, otherwise Agnes Slavin, otherwise Agnes Smyth, Widow, hereby give public notice that, by Deed Poll, dated the 16th day of July, 1945, I formally absolutely renounced and abandoned the said surnames of Slavin and Smyth, and declared that I had assumed and adopted, and intended thenceforth upon all occasions whatsoever to use and subscribe the name of Baker

instead of Slavin and Smyth, and so as to be at all times thereafter called and known by the name of Baker exclusively, and by the Christian name of Agnes, so that thenceforth I should be known as Agnes Baker and sign my name to all documents accordingly.
