

WAGES COUNCILS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1945.

SHIRTMAKING WAGES COUNCIL (NORTHERN IRELAND).

The Shirtmaking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Ministry of Labour and National Insurance proposals for the revocation of the Shirtmaking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation Order, 1946 (S. R. & O., 1946 No. 133), dated 27th June, 1946, as amended by the Shirtmaking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order, 1946 (S. R. & O. 1946, No. 173) and for the fixing of specified statutory minimum remuneration in substitution for the Current statutory minimum remuneration.

Particulars of the proposals may be obtained from the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below.

The Wages Council will consider any written representations with respect to the above-mentioned proposals which may be sent to it within twenty-one days from 9th April, 1948. Any such representation should be signed by the person making the same (adding his or her address) and sent to the Secretary, Shirtmaking Wages Council (Northern Ireland), Tyrone House, Ormeau Avenue, Belfast. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise grounds of their objections.

HEALTH SERVICES.

NORTHERN IRELAND GENERAL HEALTH SERVICES BOARD—CONSTITUTION.

Order, dated 24th March, 1948, made by the Minister of Health and Local Government under Section Four of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland), 1948.

WHEREAS by Section 4(1) of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland), 1948, it is provided that the Minister of Health and Local Government shall by order constitute in accordance with the First Schedule to the Act, a body to be called the Northern Ireland General Health Services Board.

NOW THEREFORE I, the Right Honourable William Grant, J.P., M.P., Minister of Health and Local Government, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Health Services (Constitution of the Northern Ireland General Health Services Board) Order (Northern Ireland), 1948, and shall come into operation on the date hereof.

HEALTH SERVICES.

NORTHERN IRELAND HOSPITALS AUTHORITY—CONSTITUTION.

Order, dated 25th March, 1948, made by the Minister of Health and Local Government under Section Twenty of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland), 1948.
